There will be a server at the pool starting at 11:00 am Friday through Sunday!

## Neighborhood Reminders

- ✓ **Pets** within the Grand Elk community must be leashed. Pet owners shall pick up their pet waste. Barking should be kept to a minimum. Any unattended animals should be reported to Animal Control at 970-887-2988.
- ✓ Many **children** have been reported playing on the golf course. Many of the golfers have been concerned for the children's safety and reported these activities to the Golf Shop. Please maintain their safety and keep the children within the boundaries of your home.
- ✓ The **golf course** is now open for play therefore, any activities whether walking, jogging, biking are strictly prohibited on the golf course and you must check in at the golf shop to be on the course.
- ✓ The **pool and spa** areas are for Members and their accompanied guests only. Members are required to please check in at the Golf Shop or the Grille prior to using the pool or spa just as you would for golf. A maximum number of six guests are permitted without prior approval from senior staff in the Golf Shop (Larry, Mike, and Leah). All persons using the pool or spa are asked to shower before use.
- ✓ All **Short-Term Rentals** should have registered their property with GE using the revised form on the [grandelkliving.com](http://grandelkliving.com) website or contacting RMG. Forms should be returned to RMG. The City of Granby also requires licensing and registration. Information can be found at the Town of Granby website.
- ✓ **Grand County Public Health** is recommending a 24-hour rest period with adequate sanitizing and disinfecting between guests for all short-term rentals.
- ✓ All **Short-Term Rental owners** should include the Grand Elk Good Neighbor Policies as well as Rules and Regulations in your guest handbook. Your renters are required to follow these guidelines as well.
- ✓ Summer season is here, we'd like to remind owners about the Grand Elk "**Standards of Maintenance**". Please see the attached document with important information on the Grand Elk HOA requirements for maintenance of a Homesite, including weed control.
- ✓ **Colorado fireworks** cannot explode or leave the ground. Firecrackers, rockets of any kind and mortars are also illegal. All fireworks are prohibited on public lands in Grand County, including in the Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests, Bureau of Land Management and Rocky Mountain National Park. To report a fireworks complaint, do not call 911. Call the Grand County Sheriff's Office non-emergency number at 970-725-3311 instead.
